Ladies Bible Study Group

August 11 – September 22, 2010 (7 weeks)

Study: ***Deeper Still: Faithful, Abundant and True***

Bible study teachers Kay Arthur (Faithful), Priscilla Shirer (Abundant), and Beth Moore (True) each teach two sessions of the study. They team up for a panel discussion 7th session. Daily Scripture study and personal application will take most women 15-30 minutes daily. Workbook is \$13. Carol Baldwin and Kathy Wooddall are facilitators, and women of all ages are invited to participate.

Bible Teacher Priscilla Shirer helps women navigate through the interruptions of life in this newly-released Bible study. Priscilla helps women understand that although they cannot escape life's interruptions, they can change their perspective on them. Session titles are: I Am Jonah; See Jonah Run; Desperate Times, Desperate Measures; Second Chances; Into All the World; and The Unmanageable God. Study: ***The Prodigal God***

Based on Timothy Keller's book by the same title, this Bible study challenges participants to look not only at the prodigal son but at the roles of the elder brother and father as well. Jesus' parable is as much about the elder brother as the younger, and as much about the father as the sons. Session titles are: The Parable; The People Around Jesus; The Two Lost Sons; The Elder Brother; The True Elder Brother; and the Feast of the Father. Participants Guide is \$8.
